

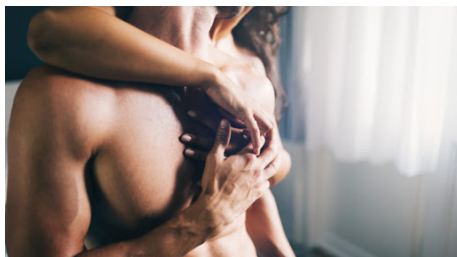


MTN Bushfire is prepared to refund your ticket
